

**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL 7-13, 2019, AS
“WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD” IN FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools, Smart Start of Forsyth County, The Forsyth Promise, and Family Services, in conjunction with the North Carolina Association for the Education of Young Children and National Association for the Education of Young Children, are celebrating April 7-13, 2019, as the “Week of the Young Child”;
