**SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:**

The County motor vehicle identified in the attached letter is no longer adequate for the needs of the County due to the following repairs that are needed: transmission replacement at an estimated cost of \$3,200, engine oil leaks at an estimated cost of \$350, and other repairs estimated to cost \$750. Even with these repairs, Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools would still like to receive this vehicle as a donation.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DONATION OF A SURPLUS, OBSOLETE,  
OR UNUSED COUNTY VEHICLE TO THE WINSTON-SALEM/FORSYTH  
COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO THE  
PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 160A-280  
(GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT)**

**WHEREAS** Forsyth County owns the following vehicle (Surplus Vehicle), identified below, which vehicle is surplus, obsolete, or unused and is therefore no longer economically beneficial to the County and should be declared surplus to the County's needs;

**WHEREAS** N.C.G.S. 160A-280 allows counties to donate to another governmental unit any personal property that the Board of County Commissioners deems surplus, obsolete, or unused;

**WHEREAS** County staff recommends that the Surplus Vehicle be declared surplus, obsolete, or unused by the County and be donated to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education to be used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools System; and

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has caused a public notice of this proposed Resolution to be posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Surplus Vehicle is hereby declared to be surplus, obsolete, or unused by the County;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the donation by Forsyth County to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education of the Surplus Vehicle pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to convey title to the Surplus Vehicle by donation to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, on the conditions that said vehicle shall be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet and that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education shall waive all rights to make any claims against Forsyth County relating to any failure of performance of the said donated vehicle, to which they agree by accepting title to the vehicles, all subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
