PICK-UP LOCATION

Forsyth County Agriculture Building
1450 Fairchild Rd., W-S

Directions to Ag. Bldg.: From I-40 West or East, take 52 N to the Airport/Liberty St. exit (111B) onto Liberty. Turn rt. at the first traffic signal onto Fairchild. Ag bldg is ½ mile on the right. **From 52 S, from Mt. Airy,** take Akron Dr. exit. Turn left onto Akron. Go to Liberty St. Turn rt onto Liberty. Go to 2nd traffic signal and turn left onto Fairchild.

PLANT INFORMATION

BLACKBERRIES: (bare root)

Cherokee: Early, thorns, very sweet.
Kiowa: World's largest blackberry, sweet, heavy producer.
Navajo: Very early, thornless, sweet.

BLUEBERRIES:

O'Neal: Very early ripening, medium-large firm fruit, good flavor, vigorous upright growth.
Premier: Early-mid season, large size berry.
Powder Blue: Late, medium, light blue berry.
TifBlue: Mid season, medium-large berry.
(At least two varieties should be planted to insure pollination.)

RASPBERRIES: (bare root)

Heritage: Ever-bearing, bright red berry, disease resistant, vigorous, winter hardy, excellent for home garden.
Caroline: Extremely productive, intense flavor, large fruit.

ASPARAGUS: (bare root)

Jersey Knight: Exceptionally large and tender spears, tight and smooth bracts, resistant to fusarium crown, root rot and rust.

STRAWBERRIES: (bare root)

Chandler: High yield, very large berry, grown by many local commercial growers.
Earliglow: Early season, medium size berry excellent for eating and freezing.

HERBS:

Our plants are grown by a local grower with the reputation of growing beautiful healthy plants.

BLUE BIRD HOUSE:

Front opening house with nesting box ready to be mounted to a tree, or hung on a wooden post or 1" pipe. Comes with a "cup" for the bird to make a nest in for easy cleaning.
