**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF A**  
**COUNTY 401(k) PLAN CONTRIBUTION FOR FORSYTH COUNTY**  
**EMPLOYEES WHO ARE PARTICIPATING IN AND**  
**CONTRIBUTING TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES'**  
**AND THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES'**  
**RETIREMENT SYSTEMS**  
**(HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT)**

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is being revised to allow Cooperative Extension Department's send-in employees to receive the County's 2.5% 401(k) contribution; those employees contribute to the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System; and

**WHEREAS**, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners appropriated funds in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Forsyth County Budget to fund a 2.5% County 401(k) Plan contribution on employees' gross County wages or salary for the benefit of Forsyth County employees who are participating in the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System or the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Manager, the Chief Financial Officer, and the Human Resources Director to implement a 2.5% County 401(k) Plan contribution on employees' gross wages or salary for the benefit of Forsyth County employees who are participating in and contributing to the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System or the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System.
