

III. Director's Update

The Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection previously issued three special orders by consent for remediation of ongoing environmental violations for three different commercial and industrial facilities. Mr. Barnette informed the Advisory Board about the progress made in each of the facilities.

Mr. Barnette informed the Advisory Board about staffing changes and updates within each division of the department. Mr. Barnette explained the challenges of solid waste and open burning violations enforced by the Community Hygiene Division. He informed the Advisory Board about ozone season and the changes implemented by the Analysis and Monitoring Division.

Mr. Barnette discussed the evidence and detrimental effects of atmospheric deposition of perfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in the southeast region of North Carolina.

Dr. Lloyd informed the Advisory Board that we are ready to move forward with the air quality awards. The Advisory Board received a list of facilities that had received violations in 2018. Dr. Lloyd asked the Advisory Board for a recommendation to proceed with the 2018 air quality awards.
